Moving to Unite

In 2010 we looked back over fifteen years and took a giant leap forward when we committed to the Pommogussett Tunnel and Trail project. The Pommogussett project is our most ambitious yet, allowing us to connect the rail trail under Route 56 and along Miles Road and to establish a Welcome Center, office and maintenance center at 21 Miles Road. The campaign to raise \$600,000 continues in 2011.

In February 2010, volunteer leaders gathered to examine our strengths and opportunities as we reviewed our accomplishments of a decade and a half and set goals to move forward. The Greenways mission — connecting the community with trails and greenways — stands. We continue working to link people with each other and with the land through the shared work of trail building and by offering healthful outdoor events.

One goal was to double our membership in 2010. We did not reach the goal, but membership did grow from 508 to 609 — a healthy increase. The MCRT grew again as we built a new mile of trail in Oakham between the 122 crossing and Coldbrook Road, installing a 110' bridge (our longest yet) over Parker Brook. Some 300 volunteers helped make it all happen.

Now we're looking ahead to a dedication in Rutland when the 'Pomm' project is complete and to a 20 year celebration in 2015. With your help, momentum is growing. Onward: one step, one smile, and one pair of helping hands at a time.

Pommogussett Tunnel and Trail Campaign

Launched in 2010, the Pommogussett Tunnel and Trail Campaign in Rutland is our most comprehensive effort yet. This project comprises the installation of the rail trail tunnel under Route 56 north of Rutland center during summer of 2011, the establishment of a Greenways Welcome Center and office at 21 Miles Road, and conservation of fifteen acres of woodland where the trail will be connected along Miles Road. Greenways purchased the land and small house at 21 Miles in December 2010, and will work to make the Welcome Center accessible to all so that it can open in 2011.

Lydia Barter stepped up to chair the campaign with support from Ted Robbins as the grants coordinator.



The total cost of this major undertaking is \$600,000. As of June 2011, the campaign had raised \$450,000. Support comes from the MA Department of Conservation and Recreation Partnership Grants, local foundations, and generous individual donors. Greenways volunteers are seeking support from

Greenways members and the community to complete this campaign.

Members Matter

Wachusett Greenway membership grew to 605 members in 2010. Members hailed from 54 towns in 9 states. In contrast, our 2009 membership was at 509. Membership in Wachusett Greenways plays a crucial role in our day-to-day operations including trail events and programs, trail maintenance activity and outreach to members. Membership is on a calendar year basis.

In 2010, over 450 supporters contributed \$34,500 to continue construction of the Mass Central Rail Trail. These gifts enable us to make steady progress in building the MCRT.

Greenways initiated the Pommogussett Tunnel and Trail Campaign in 2010. Member donations are key to the capital campaign to construct a tunnel under Pommogussett Road in Rutland (Rte 56) and to prepare our new welcome center at 21 Miles Road in Rutland.

Greenways keeps a cumulative record of your gifts. When your donation total for MCRT construction reaches \$5,000 you will be recognized with a bench inscribed in your honor on the trail. Donors of \$1,000 or more are recognized together on an engraved post at a trailhead. Every dollar you give for the MCRT Construction Fund is used for actual rail trail construction. Your donations are also maximized when they help match government grants.

Trail Goes West Again

In 2010 we completed the initial construction of 1.2 miles of new trail stretching west in Oakham from Route 122 to Coldbrook Road near the Oakham/Barre border. Along the way, the trail crosses over Parker Brook on a new 110 foot bridge, the longest we have installed to date. The bridge was manufactured by ConTec, formerly Continental Bridge, which produced the Quinapoxet Bridges. Greenways contracted Bob Salvadore of R.D. Salvadore Excavation to extend the trail. Mark Sadowski of East Hill Enterprises installed the footings for the bridge at Parker Brook. Astro Crane of Stow expertly lowered the span



into place. All this work was accomplished with the support of Greenways members and the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation Partnership and Recreational Trails Grants.

Wachusett Greenways made plans to repair damage brought



on by heavy rains in 2010, including the installation of a new culvert for the slab bridge near Muddy Pond, which was undermined by last year's storms. Once again, Bob Salvadore will handle the heavy lifting for this project.

Grant News

Our work is possible through farsighted, generous support of our partners including the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and several Worcester area foundations.

During 2010 the DCR Partnership Grant program and the DCR Recreational Grant program helped fund the construction of the rail trail in Oakham from the Route 122 crossing to Coldbrook Station. This trail section included purchase and installation of the new 110' bridge over Parker Brook and construction of the trail.

A DCR Recreational Trails Grant awarded in 2010 will assist in completion of the trail surfacing from Muddy Pond to Coldbrook Road and repair of the damaged slab bridge over Parker Brook in 2011.

Generous grantors helped launch the \$600,000 Pommogussett Tunnel and Trail Campaign. The DCR Partnership Grant program provided a grant for engineering and purchase of the concrete culvert in 2010. DCR awarded a second Partnership grant early in 2011 to help with the installation of the Pommogussett tunnel. Five wonderfully generous local foundations, George I. Alden Trust, Fred Harris Daniels Foundation, Fletcher Foundation, Hoche-Scofield Foundation and Stoddard Charitable Trust, each stepped up to contribute a total of \$140,000 to the Tunnel and Trail campaign. The Frances Alexander Foundation, Marla Maykel Fund at the Greater Worcester Community Foundation and Walmart Foundation also contributed.

We are grateful for the generous financial support, and for the vote of confidence provided by such a distinguished group of funders. Thank you!

Springdale Mill Celebration Draws a Crowd

The annual Springdale Mill Celebration was held on a beautiful day in September 2010. The site is a mile and a half equidistant from Oakdale (West Boylston) and River Street (Holden) next to the rushing Quinapoxet River. Folks can wander along paths and view remnants of the mill and village. Interpretive signs give



onlookers a glimpse into 19th century mill life and history.

Chas and Deb provided music and commentary throughout the day, while Lori Lecuyer from Wachusett Fitness organized a walk or run in memory of three year-old Dylan Seymour. Students from WPI also volunteered to paint faces and organize games for the children. The railroad engine was a big hit with many youngsters and provided many photo ops. As usual, visitors to the site enjoyed the delicious food prepared by the Spaulding family and committee members.

The Crew Tends the Trail

Unlike 2009, when so much time and effort were spent clearing ice storm debris from the rail trail and White Oak Trail, the year 2010 enabled work crews to get right down to clearing for new rail construction. “2010 was much more of a building year than a cleanup year,” said John Rives, board member and coordinator of maintenance. Volunteers cleared the trail from Route 122 a mile west to Coldbrook Station.

Dozens of families took advantage of Disney’s Give-a-Day, Get-a-Day program, in which they earned a day at Disney World for a day of service. These enthusiastic crews experienced winter trail clearing in the snow west of the Rte. 122 crossing, spring clearing at the Trout Brook upper field, and planting for trail entry landscaping.

Three Eagle scout projects were carried out this year. Brian Walsh of Holden Troop 175 developed an interpretive sign and a platform covering the old water tower near the depot at Miles Road in Rutland. He also helped clear the trail. Adam Mayer of Troop 306 Rutland began his project on the White Oak Trail working from the Sterling Road entrance including sign repair and clearing a one mile section of the trail of storm debris. Jon Staruk, Holden Troop 175, also worked on the White Oak Trail. He focused on the trailhead amenities at North Street and clearing the adjacent trail section.

West Boylston Girl Scouts, Katie Laraba and Christina Fallavolita began their Silver Award projects as they planned a very special day on the trail for brownies





and other junior scouts and set their sites to improve the bulletin boards on the West Boylston section of the rail trail. Go scouts!

Maintenance continued on existing trail sections. Employees of Vertex Pharmaceuticals of Cambridge got into the day-of-service spirit on the Sterling section of the rail trail. In a single day, they placed hundreds of large stones to reinforce eroding banks

on both sides of the Quag bridge. Work is underway to fix a culvert near Route 122 in Rutland. Here, volunteers took down several trees to make way for the heavy equipment needed to take apart the damaged culvert. In West Boylston, other volunteers removed invasive trees and plants and mulched the gardens.
