Greenways Goes the Extra Mile



In 2012, the Mass Central Rail Trail (MCRT) expanded 1.4 miles westward to cross the Ware River. From Coldbrook Road in Oakham, the trail now reaches a rest area on Route 122 in Barre. Summing up the accomplishments, Ed Yaglou MCRT Task Force chair said, "As 2012 ended all was ready for the arrival of the new 98-foot heavy-duty bridge."

Volunteer professional engineer Bruce Pennino of Holden, helped solve a vexing trail design problem this year. Bruce designed a serpentine route at a 5% grade between

the old Mass Central rail bed and the Boston & Albany line next to the Ware River. The direct route would have resulted in grades as high as 14%. Volunteer surveyor Ken Strom of Holden, spent many hours checking slopes and setting grades.

Surveyor Doug

Andrysick of Princeton also donated additional surveying. Once the route was set, Greenways contracted Chris Pirner of Hubbardston, to remove trees for trail construction. Then Greenways contracted R.J. McDonald Company of Barre to grade and build the trail from Coldbrook Road to the Ware River.

Bruce Pennino developed the bridge and abutment plans and coordinated the bridge design and manufacture with Wheeler, a Minnesota bridge company established in 1892. Structural engineer Rob Johnson, of Auburn, donated the abutment design. Greenways contracted R. D. Salvatore Excavating of Barre to construct the bridge foundation and trail extension to the rest stop in Barre. The new bridge will serve the needs of foot travelers, bicyclists reaching the MCRT and snowmobiles reaching the separate Corridor 71, as well as MA Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) maintenance vehicles. The bridge enables snowmobile trail grooming equipment to avoid a four-mile detour to reach the Corridor 71.

Opening Doors at the Welcome Center

Transforming 21 Miles Road and its grounds in Rutland to the Wachusett Greenways Welcome Center is managed by leaders Chuck Belanger and Christy Barnes. Donor gifts and volunteers, some with professional expertise and others with willing hands, are contributing to the very evident progress of the project.

Architect Dan Ferguson of Princeton donated his services. Greenways contracted with builder Mark Elbag to install an accessible bathroom and enlarge the halls for handicapped access. Other improvements included new electrical service and an energy-efficient front window. Volunteers Chuck and Christy, with help from Harold Boucher, made painstaking repairs to damaged plaster and added fresh paint. Ed Yaglou added insulation and extended the floor in the attic, saving energy and providing a good surface for storage.

Outside, volunteers installed new gutters and downspouts. A rain garden is planned for spring planting to divert water from the house. Volunteers of all ages cleared brush in preparation for the coming MCRT trail link. Doug Hagman donated his expert landscape services for lawn care and leaf removal. And neighbors Roland Veaudry and Dave Camarra steadfastly plowed the snow.

Three essential jobs remain for 2013 that will require professional contracting: building an accessible ramp and deck, replacing the rest of the single-paned windows, and replacing or rehabilitating the outside siding.

Chuck and Christy welcome more hands, especially skilled ones, and encourage you to stop by.



DCR Celebration

In June Greenways co-hosted a memorable celebration with the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) to recognize nearly two decades of partnership in building and caring for the Mass Central Rail Trail. The rain took a break as rail enthusiasts gathered at the rail trail in Rutland to thank the staunch partners who are helping to create this treasured cross-state trail. The ceremony was held at the intersection of the MCRT and the Midstate Trail in Rutland State Park. DCR Commissioner Edward Lambert announced the 2012 Partnership Matching Grant and the Recreational Trails Grant for rail trail construction.



Commissioner Lambert, Senator Steven Brewer, Representative Kim Ferguson and Rutland Selectman Joe Becker joined Greenways enthusiasts to thank the partners including the Wachusett Towns and Greenways members for developing our central section of the Mass Central Rail Trail.

Down by the Old Mill Stream

Maintenance of the Springdale Mill Interpretive Site was a priority during 2012, according to Springdale Mill Committee Chair Ruth Spaulding. All the original wooden benches at the site, in rough shape after eight years, were removed. The committee is planning to replace them with durable benches. Always on hand are Dick and Roger Spaulding, Ruth's husband and son, to help with tree cutting, mowing, moving benches, transporting the MCRT model engine for celebrations, and general maintenance throughout the year.

According to Ruth, one future vision held by the committee is the construction of a footbridge at the abutments above the trail, where a bridge once stood when the mill was in



operation and the mill hands walked down from their lodgings over the train tracks. "That's a long way off, but it's fun to think about," says Ruth.

A highlight of the year is always the Springdale Mill Celebration held on the last Saturday in September. Chas Paddock and his musical family once again provided a spirited program.

In 2012, the long-awaited Wachusett Greenways Guide and a beautiful set of maps depicting the Mass Central Rail Trail were completed.

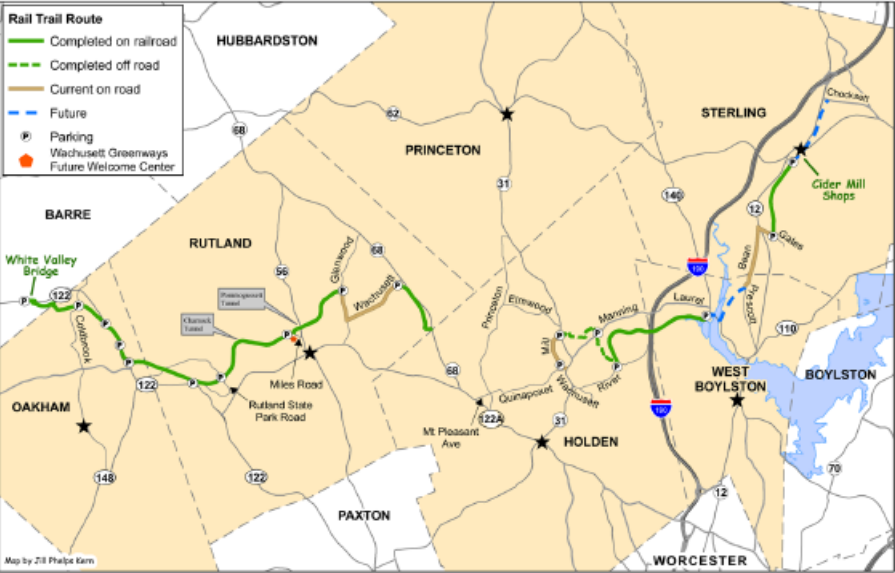
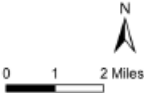

Adshead Graphics designed the guide. Vin Antul, of The Trustees of Reservations, contributed mapping support, and a generous grant from the Greater Worcester Community Foundation made it all possible.

The Mass Central Rail Trail maps were developed and donated to Wachusett Greenways by Jill Phelps Kern, who offered her professional cartographic skills for the project. The map collection consists of eight locally detailed sections plus an overview map of the Sterling to Barre portion of the MCRT. Greenways Members Are in Good Company

In 2012, for the first time, membership in Greenways passed the 700 mark. This year 703 individuals, families, and businesses from 67 towns in 13 states joined the Greenways ranks. With 60 new members, Greenways grew 12%! Membership fees, based on the calendar year, support trail events and programs, trail maintenance, and outreach. Members receive renewal invitations each spring.

In 2012, 476 donors contributed nearly \$60,000 to the Mass Central Rail Trail Construction Fund. Of those donors, 84 new contributors, gave to the MCRT fund.

For the coming year, Wachusett Greenways invites members and friends to help complete the Miles Road Welcome Center and the rail trail connection there. MCRT Construction Fund gifts will help keep the rail trail growing. Major donors of \$5,000 or more are recognized with a bench inscribed in their honor. Donors of \$1,000 or more will be recognized together on an engraved granite pillar at a trailhead. Donations are vital to our efforts and we are grateful for the support of our loyal members and generous friends.

2012 Grants

Foundations located in Central Massachusetts lead the way for Wachusett Greenways to continue expanding the Mass Central Rail Trail and serving Worcester County. In 2012 these generous foundations honored Greenways with their support: George I. Alden Trust, The Fletcher Foundation, Greater Worcester Community Foundation, and Stoddard Charitable Trust.

The shared vision of the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) is also essential for the development of the cross-state multi-use MCRT. DCR Recreational Trails Grants and a DCR Partnership Matching Fund Grant supported the development of rail trail from Coldbrook Road, Oakham to Barre, including the new Ware River Bridge.

Extending Hospitality

Offering a warm welcome is part of Greenways' mission year round. Whether greeting trail users and handing them maps, sharing news of the trail at UMass Med School's Earth Day celebration, or marching in the Oakham 250th parade, Greenways volunteers find satisfaction in reaching out. Volunteer John Rives, for example, refers to his time at Holden Days as an opportunity to help people become even more enthusiastic about our trails.

Trail counts offer opportunities to greet and count people at the trail entrance. Visitors have come from countries including Brazil, England, and China, as well as nearby New England states. Counts at the trailhead in West Boylston range from the mid-300s to more than 500 on a nice day. WG expects to hold trail counts on several trail sections in 2013.

Greenways also engages with other trail groups and coalitions within the Commonwealth, offering encouragement and trading ideas. In 2012 the Montachusett Trail Coalition formed, and Director Ed Yaglou participated for Wachusett Greenways.
