Greenways began preparing for the Mass Central Rail Trail connection along the Stillwater River/Route 140 causeway in West Boylston. Young cyclists and walkers enrolled for the inaugural Journey to the Mill as part of the Springdale Mill Celebration. Patrollers and teams of trail volunteers, ranging from Bancroft 5th graders to Vertex Pharmaceuticals volunteers, lent a hand maintaining trails. Countless friends and neighbors enjoyed the rail trail and other Wachusett trails through Greenways events.

Forging Partnerships to Build the MCRT



BUILDING AND MAINTAINING THE MCRT and other trails is truly a labor of love. The work is never done, and the beauty and utility of the trails is a product of a partnership among Wachusett Greenways' dedicated volunteers, the Commonwealth, and local towns and residents.

Our major project in 2013 was construction of the White Valley Bridge, which spans the Ware River in Barre. This 98-foot heavy-duty bridge and ample parking mark the western end of the MCRT under Wachusett Greenways' oversight. Watch a video of the bridge installation on the Greenways website.

Before wintry weather set in, we came close to completing the rail trail between the new bridge and Coldbrook Road in Oakham. This beautiful, diverse section is sure to become popular and awaits only completion of stone-dust paving in 2014.

To the east, we completed plans for a vital 0.2-mile connector between two popular sections of the MCRT, part of which will pass through the front yard of our new Welcome Center along Miles Road.

Mass. Department of Conservation & Recreation (DCR) awarded a grant of \$50,000 to improve four sections of the MCRT in Rutland, Holden and Sterling in 2014. These include the "Over the Hill" section in Holden, Cider Mill to Gates Road in Sterling, and the Charnock cut in Rutland. Greenways matching funds and services will support this work.

Finally, we began planning for engineering and design with the DCR for the rail trail connection along the Route 140 causeway at Still River in West Boylston.



Welcome Center a Beehive of Activity

DURING 2013, ENTHUSIASTIC VOLUNTEERS and contractors labored to transform the simple brown house at 21 Miles Road, Rutland, into WG's Welcome Center. Project coordinator Christy Barnes notes several volunteers who helped, including Chuck Belanger, Gary Brigham, Harold Boucher, Howard Hastings, Jeff Keay and Mike Peckar.

Progress in 2013 included:

- The floors are finished and radiators painted.
- The kitchen is plastered and painted.
- The cabinet doors are primed, painted and rehung.
- There is a new kitchen countertop, donated by Counterwerks, of Franklin, MA, with help from Annemarie Woodward, of Koopman Lumber.
- The sump pump system now delivers water to the rain garden site.
- Closets are painted.

Landscaper Doug Hagman donated mowing and leaf removal. Neighbors Dave Camarra and Seth Stidsen plowed. Seth picked up where Roland Veaudry left off when his family moved to NH.

The key project for 2014 is the accessible entry ramp. New projects include a rain garden and a proposed community garden with a peace pole. Some new doors and windows and painting or new siding are needed. Volunteers are welcome to help with final touches as we prepare to officially greet visitors!

Celebrating the Springdale Mill

MUCH OF THE RAIL TRAIL LINKING HOLDEN to West Boylston runs along the Quinapoxet River, site of several 19th Century mills, including the Springdale Woolen Mill. Today, through the dedication of Springdale Mill Committee, remnants of another age have been exposed with interpretive signage. 2013 was another active year for this enthusiastic corps of historians and neighbors.

September brought the annual Springdale Mill Family Fun Day celebration, an afternoon of music, food and activities for all ages. And this year, a bear sighting! The celebration included the first annual Journey to the Mill, a 1.5-mile group bike/walk from Oakdale to the Mill for ages up to 12.

Just before winter set in, Greenways installed a new granite bench in honor of the Springdale Mill team. Committee chair Ruth Spaulding reports, "2013 was another very active year, and we are always looking for new volunteers to help maintain and interpret the Springdale Mill Site."





Members and Donors Matter!

IN 2013 A RECORD 736 INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND BUSINESSES from 78 towns in 15 states joined the ranks of Greenways members, including 58 new members, a 4% increase. March is membership month! We welcome every loyal member and each new member! Membership donations, based on the calendar year, support trail events and programs, trail maintenance and outreach to members.

In 2013, 403 donors also contributed to the Mass Central Rail Trail Construction Fund, donating over \$55,000. 45 new donors gave to the MCRT Fund.

During 2014, Wachusett Greenways will seek donations to its MCRT Construction Fund to begin engineering and design for the Route 140 connection in West Boylston, upgrade four trail sections in Rutland, Holden and Sterling, and complete the Miles Road connection in Rutland.

Your support at every level is fundamental to completing the rail trail. Donors of a cumulative \$5,000 can have an engraved granite bench installed along the trail. Donors of \$1,000 or more will be recognized together on an engraved post at a trailhead.

- Bancroft Middle School students volunteered three times.
- Bancroft 5th graders joined us for an all-day field trip.

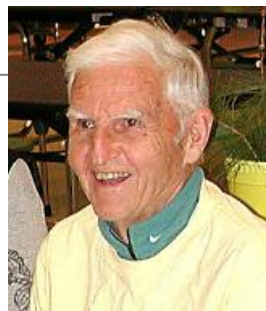

Grants Report

THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) continues to be our #1 partner in developing the Mass Central Rail Trail. DCR Recreational Trails Grants supported the trail construction and bridge development from Coldbrook Road in Oakham to the Ware River crossing along Route 122 in Barre. DCR Partnership Matching Fund Grants contributed to the development of the rail trail from Coldbrook Road, Oakham, to Barre, including the new White Valley Bridge.

Other DCR grants were also approved for projects that will be carried out in

2014. The DCR Recreational Trails Program will provide a matching grant for upgrades of four MCRT sections in Rutland, Holden and Sterling. The DCR Partnership Matching Fund Program will provide the initial 1:1 match portion for engineering and design for the rail trail connection in West Boylston at Route 140.

Through the Greater Worcester Community Foundation, WG received a grant from the Marla Maykel Fund, which has been a steady supporter.
